20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-7-201(e), pertaining to taxes imposed on	
21	alcoholic beverages, is amended as follows:	
22	(e)(1) The revenues derived from the excise tax	x on beer levied under
23	subdivision (a)(3) of this section shall be deposited in the Department of	
24	Human Services Grants Fund Account to be distributed a	as follows:
25	(A)(i) Twenty percent (20%) of the	funds shall be used to
26	provide subsidized child care for low-income families	;

15	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

18	which the retail beer tax would not exist this act must become effective on	
19	June 30, 2005; that the citizens of Arkansas are in need of the revenues	
20	generated by the retail beer tax; and that these revenues are necessary to	
21	continue funding essential programs such as subsidized child care for low-	
22	income families, the Arkansas Better Chance Program of the Department of	
23	Education, and the Child Care Development Fund. Therefore, an emergency is	
24	declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the	
25	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on June 30, 2005.
