## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PROBATION OR A SUSPENDED  
10 SENTENCE MAY BE REVOKED SUBSEQUENT TO THE PERIOD  
11 OF SUSPENSION OR PROBATION IF A PETITION TO  
12 REVOKE IS FILED PRIOR TO EXPIRATION OF THE PERIOD  
13 OF SUSPENSION OR PROBATION; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PROBATION OR A  
17 SUSPENDED SENTENCE MAY BE REVOKED  
18 SUBSEQUENT TO THE PERIOD OF SUSPENSION  
19 OR PROBATION IF A PETITION TO REVOKE IS

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-4-309(e), pertaining to revocation of a  
28 suspension or probation, is amended to read as follows:

29 (e) The court may revoke a suspension or probation subsequent to the  
30 expiration of the period of suspension or probation, provided before  
31 expiration of the period:

32 (1) The defendant is arrested for violation of suspension or  
33 probation;

34 (2) A warrant is issued for the defendant's arrest for violation  
35 of suspension or probation; ~~or~~

36 (3) A petition to revoke the defendant's suspension or probation



1 has been filed; or

2 ~~(3)~~(4) The defendant has been:

3 (A) Issued a citation in lieu of arrest under Rule 5 of  
4 the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure for violation of suspension or  
5 probation; or

6 (B) Served a summons under Rule 6 of the Arkansas Rules of  
7 Criminal Procedure for violation of suspension or probation.
