The State Board of Education shall develop rules and regulations for disbursement of the funds in a manner that insures equity in meeting the 10 11 provisions of the nurse to student ratio established in Arkansas Code 6-18-12 706. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 13 through June 30, 2007. 14 15 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 16 17 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 18 19 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 20 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 25 26 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 27 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 28 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 29 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 30 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 31 32 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 33 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 34 35 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
2	effectiveness of this Act on July 1,2005 is essential to the operation of the
3	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
4	event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
5	of this Act beyond July 1,2005 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
6	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
7	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
8	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
9	full force and effect from and after July 1,2005.
