19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-1202 is amended to read as follows:  
22 6-17-1202. Definitions.

23 As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

24 (1) "Accumulated sick leave" means the total number of days of  
25 unused sick leave that a teacher has to his credit;

26 (2) "Immediate family" includes the teacher's ~~spouse, children,~~  
27 ~~parents, and any other relatives living in the same household;~~

28 (A) Spouse;

29 (B) Child;

30 (C) Parent; or

31 (D) Any other relative if the other relative lives in the  
32 same household as the teacher;

33 (3) "Sick leave" means absence with full pay from one's duties  
34 in a public school for the reason of personal illness or illness in one's  
35 immediate family, except for an absence due to personal injury resulting from  
36 either an assault or other violent criminal act as provided in this



1 subchapter; and

2 (4) "Teacher" includes any full-time employee of a local school  
3 district who is compelled by law to secure a license from the State Board of  
4 Education as a condition precedent to employment.
