26	SECTION 1. APPROPRIAT	TIONS - VALLEY VIEW VOLUNTEER FIR	RE DEPARTMENT. There			
27	is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -

34	SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor					
35	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects					
36	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available					

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- 1 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
- 2 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
- donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 3
- 4 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
- 5 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects

- 26 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 28 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
- 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 31
- date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 32
- 33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
- Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 34
- 35 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

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safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005. 36
