21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-6-110 is amended to read as follows:  
24 11-6-110. Children under age 18 years – Hours of employment.

25 No boy or girl under the age of eighteen (18) years shall be employed,  
26 permitted, or suffered to work in any occupation:

27 (1) for more More than six (6) days in any week; ~~or~~

28 (2) more More than fifty-four (54) hours in any week, ~~nor;~~

29 (3) more More than ten (10) consecutive hours in any one (1)

30 day;

31 (4) More than ten (10) hours in a twenty-four-hour period; or

32 (5) before Before 6:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m., except that the  
33 ~~limitation~~ limitations of 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. shall not apply to  
34 children under the age of eighteen (18) years employed on nights preceding  
35 nonschool days.
