BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-6-110 is amended to read as follows:
11-6-110. Children under age 18 years - Hours of employment.
No boy or girl under the age of eighteen (18) years shall be employed, permitted, or suffered to work in any occupation:
(1) for more More than six (6) days in any week; of
(2) more More than fifty-four (54) hours in any week, nor;
(3) more More than ten (10) consecutive hours in any one (1) day;
(4) More than ten (10) hours in a twenty-four-hour period; or
(5) before Before 6:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m., except that the limitation limitations of 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. shall not apply to children under the age of eighteen (18) years employed on nights preceding nonschool days in occupations determined by rule of the Arkansas Department of Labor to be sufficiently safe for their employment.
