EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 23 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that third party administration of 24 certain driving tests is necessary to ensure a adequate opportunity for qualified applicants to take the test; that there are qualified and trained 25 26 students currently waiting to take the test; and that this act is immediately 27 necessary to correct deficiencies in the current testing procedures. 28 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately 29 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall 30 become effective on: 31 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 32 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 33 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the 34 bill; or 35 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto. 36
