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19	SECTION 1. Arkansas C	ode § 14-55-203 is amend	ded to read as follows:	
20	14-55-203. Voting requirements for passage - Effective dates.			
21	(a) On the passage of every bylaw, ordinance, resolution, or order to			
22	enter into a contract by the council of any municipal corporation, the yeas			
23	and nays shall be called and	recorded.		
24	(b) To pass any bylaw, ordinance, resolution, or order, a concurrence			
25	of a majority of a whole num	ber of members elected t	to the council shall be	
26	required.			
27	(c) The effective dat	es for ordinances <u>of a g</u>	general or permanent	
28	nature and other local measu	res <u>of a general or perm</u>	nanent nature of cities of	
29	the first class, cities of t	he second class, and inc	corporated towns shall be	
30	as follows:			
31	(1) Upon public	ation or posting as is c	otherwise required by law,

4	(3) An ordinance containing an emergency clause shall go into		
5	effect immediately upon passage or at the time specified by the emergency		
6	clause, regardless of publication or posting, but an emergency clause shall		
7	not be effective to impose any fine, penalty, forfeiture, or deprivation of		
8	liberty or property until after the ordinance has been published or posted as		
9	is otherwise required by law.		
10	(d) The effective date of an ordinance that is not of a general or		
11	permanent nature of a city of the first class, city of the second class, or		
12	incorporated town is the date of passage of the ordinance unless a later		
13	effective date is provided in the ordinance.		
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15	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
16	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the laws concerning the		
17	effective dates of local ordinances are in need of immediate clarification;		
18	that the orderly administration of cities requires certainty in the		
19	application of local laws; and that this act is necessary to ensure that		
20	local residents and city administration have clear direction in the		
21	applicability and effective dates of local ordinances. Therefore, an		
22	emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for		
23	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become		
24	effective on:		
25	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
26	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
27	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
28	bill; or		
29	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
30	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
