1 (c) During the time the ballots may be retained or stored, the package 2 containing them shall not be opened by anyone unless directed to do so by 3 some competent tribunal before which an election contest or prosecution is 4 pending in which the ballots are to be used as evidence.

5 (d) For a period of twenty (20) days, the county treasurer shall 6 retain the custody of and safely keep all ballot stubs in a sealed container 7 appropriately marked which are delivered to him from the several precincts, 8 after which time they shall be stored unless an election contest has been 9 filed or a criminal prosecution has been initiated in connection with the 10 election.

11 (e) After a period of two (2) years, all <u>marked</u> ballots and ballot 12 stubs may be destroyed in the following manner:

13 (1) The county board shall enter an order directing the
14 destruction of <u>marked</u> ballots and ballot stubs;

15 (2) The county board shall make and retain a record of <u>marked</u>
16 ballots and ballot stubs destroyed; and

17 (3) The county board shall file the order and record pertaining
18 to <u>marked</u> ballots and ballot stubs destroyed with the county clerk.

19 (f)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (f)(2) of this section,
20 after a period of thirty (30) days following certification of the election,
21 all ballot stubs which were previously attached to marked ballots and all
22 unmarked ballots may be destroyed as provided for the destruction of marked

23 ballots in subsection (e) of this section.

24 (2) If an election contest has been filed, all ballot stubs
25 which were previously attached to marked ballots may be destroyed thirty (30)
