15	necessary because a delay in its implementation could prevent it from		
16	applying to some elections. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and		
17	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
18	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
19	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
20	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
