19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-10-103 is amended to read as follows:
22 19-10-103. State employee not to represent claimant.

23 (a) No full-time employee of the State of Arkansas or of its agencies,
24 nor a member of any agency, shall appear before either the Arkansas State
25 Claims Commission or the Workers' Compensation Commission as attorney or
26 representative for any claimant in the presentation or prosecution of any
27 claim filed under this chapter.

28 (b) As used in this section, "full-time employee" means any person who
29 works at least one thousand (1,000) hours per year for a state agency,
30 department, board, or commission of the State of Arkansas and participates in
31 the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System or another public employees
32 retirement system.
