16 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE
17 UNIVERSITY - HEBER SPRINGS APPROPRIATION
18 FOR THE 2005-2007 BIENNIUM.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
25 State University - Heber Springs for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
34 or its successor.

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8 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas State
 9 University - Heber Springs for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum
 10 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",
 11 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty (20)
 12 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
 13 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 14 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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16 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 17 to the Arkansas State University - Heber Springs, to be payable from the
 18 Arkansas State University - Heber Springs Fund, for personal services and
 19 operating expenses each fiscal year of the biennial period ending June 30,
 20 2007, the sum of\$350,000.

22 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 23 the Arkansas State University - Heber Springs, to be payable from cash funds
 24 as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas State University - Heber
 25 Springs, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas State
 26 University - Heber Springs for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the
 27 following:

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12 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code 19-5-303(g)(1) is amended to
 13 read as follows:

14 (g)(1) Arkansas State University - Beebe Fund. There is established on the
 15 books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal
 16 Officer of the State a fund to be known as the "Arkansas State University -
 17 Beebe Fund".

18 (2) The fund shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement
 19 of Arkansas State University-Beebe, including the Arkansas State Technical
 20 Institute, and Arkansas State University-Searcy, ~~and Arkansas State~~
 21 ~~University Heber Springs.~~

22 (3) The fund shall consist of:

23 (A) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

24 (B) The June 30, 2003, balance in the Foothills Technical Institute Fund
 25 Account; and

26 (C) Any other funds made available for the support of the university which
 27 are required to be deposited into the State Treasury by law.

28

29 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code 19-5-303 is amended by adding a
 30 new section to read as follows:

31 (bb)(1) Arkansas State University - Heber Springs Fund. There is established
 32 on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief
 33 Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the "Arkansas State
 34 University - Heber Springs Fund".

35 (2) The fund shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement
 36 of Arkansas State University-Heber Springs.

- 1 (3) The fund shall consist of:
- 2 (A) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; and
- 3 (B) Any other funds made available for the support of the university which
- 4 are required to be deposited into the State Treasury by law.

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6 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND

8 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged

9 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the

10 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief

11 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December

12 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or

13 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during

14 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.

15 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the

16 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon

17 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal

18 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board

19 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005

21 through June 30, 2007.

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23 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

24 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

25 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

26 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures

29 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this

30 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

31 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

32 with in disbursement of said funds.

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34 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

36 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

1 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
2 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
3 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
4 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
5 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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7 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
10 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
14 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.

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
