29 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 23-112-201 is amended to read as follows: 23-112-201. Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission - Creation - Members -30 31 Officers.

- 32 (a) There is created the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission, hereinafter 33 referred to as the commission, to be composed of nine (9) members to be appointed by the Governor for terms of seven (7) years, subject to 34 35 confirmation by the Senate.
- (b)(1) One (1) commissioner shall be appointed from each of the four (4) 36

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- congressional districts of the state as constituted July 1, 1975, and five

 members of the commission, including the consumer representative and the

 representative of the elderly, shall be appointed from the state at large.
 - (2)(A) Four (4) members of the commission shall be licensees or shall be qualified as licensees under the provisions of this chapter at the time of their appointment.
 - (B) Five (5) members of the commission shall be appointed from the public at large, including the consumer representative and the representative of the elderly.
- 10 (C) No more than four (4) members of the commission shall at any
 11 time be licensees under this chapter, of have any financial interest in, or
 12 be an officer or an employee of, a licensee of this chapter, or be employed
 13 by or own a business or organization that directly or indirectly profits from

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
