## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CLARIFY A COUNTY COURT'S ACCEPTANCE OF  
STREETS AND ROADS IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THE  
COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO CLARIFY A COUNTY COURT'S  
ACCEPTANCE OF STREETS AND ROADS IN  
UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THE COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-66-207 is amended to read as follows:  
27-66-207. Streets or roads dedicated to the public.

(a) The county judge, in his discretion, may designate as a county  
road any street or road dedicated to the public as a public thoroughfare,  
provided that a bill of assurance making the dedication is properly recorded.

(b) Unless a plat clearly reflects roads are private roads, the county  
recorder shall not accept any plats in the unincorporated area of the county  
without the county court's acceptance of:

(1) Roads for perpetual maintenance; and

(2) Dedication of land for public purposes.
