14	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 4-35-110 is amended to read as follows:		
15	4-35-110. Revenues.		
16	(a) A water authority formed pursuant to this chapter shall be		
17	operated without profit, but the rates, fees, rents, or other charges for		
18	water or wastewater collection, disposal, and treatment and other facilities,		
19	supplies, equipment, or services furnished by the water authority shall be		
20	sufficient at all times:		
21	(1) To pay all operating and maintenance expenses necessary or		
22	desirable for the prudent conduct of its affairs and the principal of and		
23	interest on the obligations issued or assumed by the water authority in the		
24	performance of the purposes for which it was organized; and		
25	(2) For the creation of adequate reserves.		
26	(b) The revenues of the water authority shall be devoted first to the		
27	payment of operating and maintenance expenses and the principal and interest		
28	on outstanding obligations, and thereafter to reserves for improvements, new		
29	construction, depreciation, and contingencies as the board of directors may		
30	from time to time prescribe and to other purposes approved by the board,		
31	including rebates to water users.		
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33	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 4-35-210(18) and (19), concerning the		
34	powers of a water authority, is amended to read as follows:		
35	(18) To own and operate facilities necessary to provide potable		
36	water and associated services and to provide wastewater collection, disposal.
