(4) The number of service connections for nontransient noncommunity water systems shall be calculated by dividing the population served by two and one-half (2.5); (5) The number of service connections for community public water systems not serving discrete service connections shall be calculated by dividing the population served by two and one-half (2.5). SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly that the Department of Health bills public water systems for fees concurrent with the beginning of the state fiscal year; that the effectiveness of this act on July 1, 2005, is essential to the operation of the Department of Health; and that in the event of an extension of the regular session, the delay in the effective date of this act beyond July 1, 2005, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005. 2.8
