1 additional contractual services as necessary and that transfers between line 2 items and among appropriations are anticipated to accomplish those purposes. 3 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 4 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 5 6 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 7 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 8 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 9 has determined that the Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation may operate more efficiently if some 10 11 flexibility is provided to the Director of the Department of Education -12 Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation authorizing 13 broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision herein. Therefore, it is 14 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 15 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 16 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 17 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 18 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 19 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 20 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 22 through June 30, 2007. 23 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER. 26 Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of 27 the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer and 28 Auditor of State the sum of forty million dollars (\$40,000,000) from the 85th 29 Session Projects Account of the General Improvement Fund, or so much thereof 30 as is available from time to time until the total of \$40,000,000 has been transferred, to the Educational Facilities Partnership Fund Account to 31 32 provide funds for the appropriation provided herein. 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 34 through June 30, 2007. 35

- 14 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 15 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 16 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 17 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 20 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 25 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 26 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 27 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 28 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 30 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 31 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 33 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 34 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 35 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 36 <u>effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of</u>

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1	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
2	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
3	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
4	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
5	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
6	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
7	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
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
