15 TO ALLOW FORMER MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES TO
16 RECEIVE THE SAME HEALTH INSURANCE
17 BENEFITS ALLOWED FOR ACTIVE EMPLOYEES.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-12-129 is amended to read as follows:
24 24-12-129. Municipal officials and employees.

25 When any municipal official or municipal employee age fifty-five (55)
26 or over who has completed twenty (20) years of service to the municipality
27 and who is vested in the retirement system retires, the official or employee
28 may continue to participate in the municipality's health care plan, receiving
29 the same medical benefits and paying the same premium as active employees
30 with the municipality paying the employer as long as the retired official or
31 employee pays both employer and employee contributions to the health care
32 plan.
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
