10 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

13 AN ACT TO AMEND THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
14 LAWS.

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-75-203 is amended to read as follows:*
20 *26-75-203. Definitions.*

21 *As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:*

22 (1) *"City" means any city of the first class, city of the second*
23 *class, or incorporated town of the State of Arkansas;*

24 (2) *"Director" means the Director of the Department of Finance*
25 *and Administration, or any successor thereof, or any authorized agent*
26 *thereof;*

27 (3) *"Capital improvements of a public nature" means:*

28 (A) ~~Streets~~ Street facilities;

29 (B) ~~Roads~~ Road facilities;

30 (C) Public parks and other recreational facilities;

31 (D) Port facilities;

32 (E) Tourism facilities;

33 (F) Airport facilities;

34 (G) Sewerage facilities;

35 (H) Waterworks facilities;

36 (I) Fire protection facilities;

2 (K) City halls and other municipal buildings;
3 (L) Courthouses;
4 (M) Police facilities;
5 (N) Public transit facilities;
6 (O) Auditoriums;
7 (P) Prisons;
8 (Q) Libraries;
9 (R) Hospital and nursing home facilities;
10 (S) Solid waste facilities;
11 (T) Sanitation facilities;
12 (U) Bridges;
13 (V) Electric facilities;
14 (W) Hydroelectric facilities;

18 (Z) Parking facilities;

27 (4) "Facilities" means real property, personal property, or
28 mixed property of any and every kind, including, without limitation, rights-
29 of-way, utilities, vehicles, materials, equipment, fixtures, machinery,
30 furniture, furnishings, buildings, and other improvements of every kind;

31 (5) "Acquire" means to obtain at any time by gift, purchase, or
32 other arrangement any capital improvement of a public nature, or any portion
33 thereof, whether theretofore constructed and equipped, theretofore partially
34 constructed and equipped, or being constructed and equipped at the time of
35 acquisition for such consideration and pursuant to such terms and conditions
36 as the governing body of the municipality shall determine;

1 (6) "Construct" means to build, in whole or in part, in such
2 manner and by such method, including contracting therefor, and if the latter,
3 by negotiation or bidding upon such terms and pursuant to such advertising as
4 determined by the governing body of the municipality, under the circumstances
5 existing at the time, as will most effectively serve the purposes of this
6 subchapter;

7 (7) "Equip" means to install or place in or on any building or
8 structure equipment of any and every kind, whether or not affixed, including,
9 without limitations, building service equipment, fixtures, heating equipment,
10 air conditioning equipment, machinery, furniture, furnishings, and personal
11 property of every kind;

12 (8) "Lease" means a lease of capital improvements of a public
13 nature by and between a city as lessee and another person as lessor, except
14 as used in § 26-75-214; and

15 (9) "Calendar quarter" means the three-month period beginning on
16 January 1, April 1, July 1, or October 1.

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19 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
20 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is a need for the law to
21 include other facilities and buildings in the definition of "capital
22 improvements of a public nature" and vehicles in the definition of
23 "facilities" to provide the means for cities to accomplish needed municipal
24 projects; that this act is necessary to correct deficiencies in the law; and
25 that this act is immediately necessary because cities need the ability to
26 begin the steps necessary to accomplish municipal projects. Therefore, an
27 emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for
28 the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
29 effective on:

30 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

31 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
32 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
33 bill; or

34 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
35 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
