BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-28-309(b)(l), pertaining to penalties, is amended to read as follows:
(b)(1) A civil penalty may be assessed by the Board of Electrical Examiners of the State of Arkansas on against any person, firm, or corporation if after a hearing by the Department of Labor and subject to appeal and hearing before the Board of Electrical Examiners of the State of Arkansas according to the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq., if it is determined that the person, firm, or corporation has violated any:
(A) Provision of this chapter;
(B) Provision in the Arkansas Electrical Code Authority

(C) Rule, regulation, or order issued or promulgated by the board; or
(D) Condition of a license, certificate, or registration issued by the board.
