24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-28-309(b)(1), pertaining to penalties,  
27 is amended to read as follows:

28 (b)(1) A civil penalty may be assessed ~~by the Board of Electrical~~  
29 ~~Examiners of the State of Arkansas on~~ against any person, firm, or  
30 corporation ~~if after a hearing by the Department of Labor and subject to~~  
31 appeal and hearing before the Board of Electrical Examiners of the State of  
32 Arkansas according to the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201  
33 et seq., if it is determined that the person, firm, or corporation has  
34 violated any:

- 35 (A) Provision of this chapter;  
36 (B) Provision in the Arkansas Electrical Code Authority



1 Act, § 20-31-101 et seq.;

2 (C) Rule, regulation, or order issued or promulgated by  
3 the board; or

4 (D) Condition of a license, certificate, or registration  
5 issued by the board.
