## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 6-63-305 CONCERNING  
NEW OR ADDITIONAL POSITIONS FOR THE VARIOUS  
INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION  
PROVISIONAL POSITIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-63-305(b), concerning new or additional positions for institutions of higher education is amended to read as follows:

(b) The following maximum number of new additional positions is established for the biennium for the following institutions of higher education at salary rates not to exceed the salary rate of comparable positions established in the regular salaries section of the biennial appropriations act for operations for each institution:

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas, that various changes in law are needed for the institutions of higher education including the authorization of additional positions due to additional funds received other than general revenue for various programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
