19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-18-206, concerning public school choice, is
22 amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

23 (j)(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, any other state
24 law, State Board of Education rule, or local school district policies, a
25 child residing in a residential subdivision that is within the boundaries of
26 two (2) or more school districts may attend any school district with
27 boundaries encompassing the subdivision.

28 (2) For purposes of this subsection (j), "residential
29 subdivision" means land divided for predominantly residential purposes into
30 such parcels as required by local ordinances or, in the absence of local
31 ordinances, the term "residential subdivision" means any land that is divided
32 by a common owner or owners for predominantly residential purposes into three
33 (3) or more lots or parcels, any of which contain fewer than three (3) acres,
34 or into platted or unplatted units any of which contain fewer than three (3)
35 acres, as a part of a uniform plan of development.
