BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1 is amended to add and additional subchapter to read as follows:

6-17-118. Leave of absence for teachers elected to the General
Assembly.
(a) A teacher who is elected to the General Assembly has the right during any regular or extraordinary session of the General Assembly to either:
(1) A leave of absence under § 21-4-101; or
(2) Paid leave on the condition that the teacher:
(A) Reimburses the school district for the cost of a substitute teacher; and
(B) Agrees to continue all contractual duties except
actual personal presence in the instructional environment.
