Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1 is amended to add and additional subchapter to read as follows:

6-17-118. Leave of absence for certified school personnel elected to the General Assembly.
(a) Certified school personnel who are elected to the General Assembly have the right during any regular or extraordinary session of the General Assembly to either:
(1) A leave of absence under § 21-4-101; or
(2) Paid leave on the condition that the certified school
person:
(A) Reimburses the local school district for the cost of a substitute; and
(B) Agrees to continue all contractual duties except actual personal presence in the school environment.
(b) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
