12	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
13	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that public toilet and restroom		
14	facilities in financial institutions cannot be provided in a safe and secure		
15	manner; that because requiring financial institutions to maintain the		
16	facilities is adverse to the safety and well-being of their customers and		
17	employees; and that this act is immediately necessary to protect the public.		
18	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately		
19	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
20	become effective on:		
21	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
22	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
23	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
24	<pre>bill; or</pre>		
25	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
26	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
