12 TO DETERMINE STUDENT ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE
13 FINANCIAL AID PROGRAMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 80, Subchapter 1 is amended
25 to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 6-80-106. Transcripts.

27 (a)(1) By May 1, 2007, the Department of Higher Education, in
28 cooperation with the Department of Education, shall prescribe a uniform
29 method of formatting transcripts which shall be used by all grades nine
30 through twelve (9-12) high schools and institutions of higher education in
31 the state.

32 (2) The uniform transcripts shall be transmitted electronically
33 to the Department of Higher Education as necessary to process state financial
34 aid applications for both high school students and higher education students.

35 (b) After implementation of the uniform method prescribed under
36 subsection (a) of this section, no institution of higher education shall be



1 eligible to receive state financial aid on behalf of students unless the
2 institution provides uniform, electronic transcripts as prescribed by the
3 Department of Higher Education under this section.
