permit issued by the office as authorized in § 27-14-708; (2) Any vehicle which is driven or moved upon a highway only for the purpose of crossing such highway from one (1) property to another; (3) Any implement of husbandry that is only incidentally operated or moved upon a highway whether or not it is of a type otherwise subject to registration under this chapter or not which is only incidentally operated or moved upon a highway if the incidental use may be established by an affidavit of the owner of the implement of husbandry; (4) Any special mobile equipment as defined in § 27-14-211; and (5) Any vehicle which is propelled exclusively by electric power obtained from overhead trolley wires, though not operated upon rails;. (6) (b) No certificates of title need be obtained for any vehicle of a type subject to registration owned by the federal government.
