21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-13-1106(c), concerning misdemeanor
24 offenses that subject emergency medical technicians to disqualification, is
25 amended to read as follows:

26 (c) An applicant shall not be disqualified from certification or
27 recertification when the applicant has been found guilty of or has pled
28 guilty or nolo contendere to a misdemeanor if the offense ~~did~~:

29 (1) Did not involve exploitation of an adult, abuse of a person,
30 neglect of a person, or sexual contact; or

31 (2) Was not committed while performing the duties of an
32 emergency medical technician.
