15 AN ACT TO EXEMPT ACTIVE DUTY MEMBERS OF
16 THE ARKANSAS NATIONAL GUARD FROM THE
17 LICENSING REQUIREMENT TO CARRY A
18 CONCEALED HANDGUN.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 73, Subchapter 3 is amended*
24 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

25 5-73-320. License for certain members of the Arkansas National Guard.

26 (a) The Department of Arkansas State Police may issue a license under
27 this subchapter to a person who:

28 (1) Is currently serving as a federally recognized commissioned
29 or noncommissioned officer of the Arkansas National Guard;

30 (2) Submits the following documents:

31 (A) A completed concealed handgun license application as
32 prescribed by the Department of Arkansas State Police;

33 (B) A form specified by the Director of the Department of
34 Arkansas State Police reflecting the fingerprints of the soldier or airman;

35 (C) A dated letter personally signed by a commanding
36 officer or his or her designee stating that the soldier or airman:



1 (i) Is a current member of the Arkansas National
2 Guard;

3 (ii) Is of good character and sound judgment;

4 (iii) Is not disqualified by state or federal law
5 from possessing a firearm;

6 (iv) Has met the military qualification requirements
7 for issuance and operation of a handgun within one (1) year of the
8 application date; and

9 (v) Has been a resident of the State of Arkansas for
10 the twelve-month period preceding the application date according to the
11 military and pay records of the soldier or airman;

12 (D) A copy of the military range qualification score card
13 signed and dated within one (1) year of the application date by a range
14 officer or noncommissioned officer in charge of the range; and

15 (E) A copy of the face or photograph side of a current
16 United States Uniformed Services military identification card for members of
17 the armed services; and

18 (3) Submits the required application fee or fees.

19 (b)(1) A license issued under this section shall expire four (4) years
20 from the date of issuance or upon the expiration date of the military
21 identification card of the soldier or airman, whichever occurs first.

22 (2) A license issued under this section shall be renewable under
23 the provisions of § 5-73-313 upon satisfaction of the requirements described
24 in subsection (a) of this section.

25 (c) Except as otherwise specifically stated in this section, the
26 license issued under this section shall be subject to the provisions of §§ 5-
27 73-301 – 5-73-319 and any rules promulgated under § 5-73-317.
