25 SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
26 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas, that changes in law are needed for
27 the institutions of higher education including the authorization of
28 additional vehicles to maintain efficient operations of campuses. Therefore,
29 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
30 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
31 full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
