19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-31-103 is amended to read as follows:
22 16-31-103. Exemptions from service.

23 (a) Any person may be excused from serving as a grand or petit juror
24 or a jury commissioner for such period as the court deems necessary or may
25 have his service deferred to another specified term of court when the state
26 of his health or that of his family reasonably requires his absence, or when,
27 for any reason, his own interests or those of the public will, in the opinion
28 of the court, be materially injured by his attendance.

29 (b) The following persons shall not be required to serve as a grand or
30 petit juror if they object to serving and make their objections known to the
31 court prior to being sworn:

- 32 (1) Practicing physicians;
33 (2) Nurses;
34 (3) Dentists; or
35 (4) Dental hygienists.
