## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY CONCERNING RAILROAD CROSSINGS IN CITIES OF THE FIRST AND SECOND CLASS AND INCORPORATED TOWNS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 23, Chapter 12, Subchapter 3 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

23-12-309. Crossings - Public safety.
(a) On or before January 1, 2009, every entity owning, controlling, or operating railroad tracks in this state shall install an automatic gate assembly with flashing lights at all railroad crossings within the corporate limits of cities of the first class, cities of the second class, and incorporated towns within this state.
(b) This section shall not apply to:
(1) An entity owning, controlling, or operating railroad tracks that are located solely within one (1) county; or
(2) An entity owning, controlling, or operating railroad tracks that are used solely for the purpose of transporting passengers.
(c) An entity owning, controlling, or operating railroad tracks in
this state that fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of this
section on or before January 1, 2009, shall be subject to a fine of one thousand dollars $(\$ 1,000)$ per day for each day that the automatic gate assemblies are not installed and operational.
