For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO ANNUALLY
OFFER THE THIRTY-EIGHT (38) UNITS REQUIRED UNDER
THE STANDARDS FOR ACCREDITATION OF ARKANSAS
PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF A STUDENT IS ENROLLED IN THE
CLASS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A SCHOOL DISTRICT TO
ANNUALLY OFFER THE THIRTY-EIGHT (38)
UNITS REQUIRED UNDER THE STANDARDS FOR
ACCREDITATION OF ARKANSAS PUBLIC SCHOOLS
IF A STUDENT IS ENROLLED IN THE CLASS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) A school district shall annually offer the thirty-eight (38) units as required under the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools to students in grades nine through twelve (9-12) as appropriate, and each unit shall be taught annually if any student enrolls in and attends the course.

(b) A school district shall not be required to teach the course if no student enrolls in the course, and all students eligible for the course, or their parents, sign a waiver stating that they do not want to take the course.
