23	(a)(1) If the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission receives
24	a written complaint that supports reasonable cause to believe that the
25	Arkansas Poultry Feeding Operations Registration Act, § 15-20-901 et seq.,
26	the Arkansas Soil Nutrient Management Planner and Applicator Certification
27	Act, § 15-20-1001 et seq., or the Arkansas Soil Nutrient Application and
28	Poultry Litter Utilization Act, § 15-20-1101 et seq. is being or has been
29	violated, commission personnel may request entry onto any public or private
30	property to inspect any regulated facility or activity.
31	(2) The commission's investigation or inspection shall be:
32	(A) Limited to that necessary to confirm or deny the cause
33	that prompted the investigation or inspection; and
34	(B) Conducted during a time convenient for the owner,
35	operator, or agent in charge of the regulated facility or activity or, under
36	emergency or extraordinary circumstances, at a time necessary to observe the

1	suspected violation or unauthorized conduct.
2	(3) At the time of the inspection, except under emergency
3	circumstances, the commission shall inform the owner, operator, or agent in
4	charge of the regulated facility or activity of all information that forms
5	the basis of the probable cause.
6	(b) For the purpose of this subchapter, a rebuttable presumption
7	concerning the jurisdiction of the commission's regulatory authority is
8	established with regard to the commission's authority to inspect any
9	regulated facility or activity.
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11	15-20-1204. Administrative warrants Exceptions.
12	(a) If consent to inspect under § 15-20-1203 is denied, the Arkansas
13	Soil and Water Conservation Commission may obtain an administrative
14	inspection warrant from a judicial officer.
15	(b) Issuance and execution of administrative inspection warrants shall
16	be as follows:
17	(1) Any judicial officer otherwise authorized to issue search
18	warrants within the officer's jurisdiction may issue warrants, upon proper
19	oath or affirmation showing probable cause as defined in this subchapter, for
20	the purpose of conducting administrative inspections authorized under the
21	Arkansas Poultry Feeding Operations Registration Act, § 15-20-901 et seq.,
22	the Arkansas Soil Nutrient Management Planner and Applicator Certification
23	Act, § 15-20-1001 et seq., or the Arkansas Soil Nutrient Application and
24	Poultry Litter Utilization Act, § 15-20-1101 et seq.;
25	(2)(A) A warrant shall issue only upon a written complaint as
26	described in § 15-20-1202 sworn to before the judicial officer, and
27	establishing the grounds for issuing the warrant.
28	(B) If the judicial officer is satisfied that grounds for
29	the application exist or that there is probable cause to believe they exist,
30	the judicial officer shall issue a warrant identifying:
31	(i) The facility to be inspected; and
32	(ii) The purpose of the inspection;
33	(3) An administrative warrant under this subchapter shall:
34	(A) State:
35	(i) The grounds for issuance of the warrant; and
36	(ii) The name of each person whose affidavit has

	been taken in support of the warrant,
2	(B) Be directed to a commission or conservation district
3	officer or employee;
4	(C) Command the person to whom it is directed to inspect
5	the area, premises, building, or conveyance identified for the purpose
6	<pre>specified;</pre>
7	(D) Specifically identify any documents or samples to be
8	gathered during the inspection;
9	(E) Direct that the warrant be served during a time
10	convenient for the owner, operator, or agent in charge of the regulated
11	facility or activity unless emergency or extraordinary circumstances compel
12	otherwise; and
13	(F) Designate the judicial officer to whom it shall be
14	returned;
15	(4)(A) If appropriate, the warrant may authorize the review and
16	copying of documents that may be relevant to the purpose of the inspection.
17	(B)(i) If documents must be seized for the purpose of
18	copying, the person serving the warrant shall prepare an inventory of
19	documents taken.
20	(ii) The inventory shall be made in the presence of
21	the person executing the warrant and of the person from whose possession or
22	facility the documents were taken, if present, or in the presence of at least
23	one (1) credible person other than the person executing the warrant.
24	(iii) A copy of the inventory shall be delivered to
25	the person from whom or from whose facility the documents were taken.
26	(iv) As soon as feasible under circumstances
27	preserving their authenticity, the seized documents shall be:
28	(a) Copied; and
29	(b) Returned to the person from whom the
30	documents were taken;
31	(5)(A) The warrant may authorize the taking of samples of
32	materials generated, stored, or treated at the facility, or of the water,
33	air, or soils within the facility's control or that may have been affected by
34	the facility's operations.
35	(B)(i) The person executing the warrant shall prepare an
36	inventory of all samples taken

1	(ii) In any inspection conducted pursuant to an
2	administrative warrant in which such samples are taken, the commission shall
3	make split samples available to the person whose facility is being inspected
4	(6)(A) A warrant issued under this section shall be executed and
5	returned within ten (10) days of its date of issuance unless, upon a showing
6	of a need for additional time, the judicial officer orders otherwise.
7	(B) The return of the warrant shall be:
8	(i) Made promptly; and
9	(ii) Accompanied by a written inventory of any
10	documents or samples taken;
11	(7) The judicial officer who has issued a warrant shall:
12	(A) Attach to the warrant a copy of the return and all
13	papers returnable in connection with the warrant; and
14	(B) File them with the clerk of the circuit court for the
15	judicial district where the inspection was made; and
16	(8) A copy of the warrant and all supporting affidavits shall
17	<u>be:</u>
18	(A) Provided to the person served; or
19	(B) Left at the entry of the facility inspected.
20	(c) An administrative warrant shall not be required for any
21	inspection, including the review and copying of documents and taking of
22	<pre>samples if:</pre>
23	(1)(A) For a regulated facility or activity, the permit,
24	license, certification, or operational approval from the commission states
25	that the commission may inspect the facility or activity to ensure
26	<pre>compliance.</pre>
27	(B) If the commission has reason to believe that a
28	violation of the Arkansas Poultry Feeding Operations Registration Act, § 15-
29	20-901 et seq., the Arkansas Soil Nutrient Management Planner and Applicator
30	Certification Act, § 15-20-1001 et seq., or the Arkansas Soil Nutrient
31	Application and Poultry Litter Utilization Act, § 15-20-1101 et seq. is
32	occurring, the basis for that belief shall be communicated to the facility
33	owner, operator, or agent in charge at the time of the inspection;
34	(2) The owner, operator, or agent in charge of the facility
35	consents;
36	(3) In an emergency, time or opportunity to apply for a warrant

1	is lacking;
2	(4) The situation:
3	(A) Presents imminent danger to public health and safety;
4	and on the same of
5	(B) Involves inspection of conveyances if there is
6	reasonable cause to believe that the mobility of the conveyance makes it
7	impracticable to obtain a warrant; or
8	(5) A warrant is not constitutionally required.
9	(d) This section does not prevent the inspection without a warrant of
10	books and records pursuant to an administrative subpoena issued in accordance
11	with duly adopted administrative procedures.
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13	15-20-1205. Penalties.
14	Any willful and unjustified refusal of right of entry and inspection
15	created through a warrant issued under this subchapter for Arkansas Soil and
16	Water Conservation Commission personnel shall be subject to civil penalties
17	of up to five hundred dollars (\$500).
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
