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1	27-16-1103. Time limit for requirements to be met.
2	(a) The Office of Driver Services of the Revenue Division of the
3	Department of Finance and Administration shall implement the changes required
4	by this subchapter for all new driver's licenses issued or renewed on or
5	before October 1, 2005.
6	(b)(1) Except as provided under subdivision (b)(2) and subsection (d)
7	of this section, beginning four (4) years after the effective date of this
8	subchapter, a state agency may not accept for any purpose a driver's license
9	or identification card that was not issued under the requirements of this
10	<u>subchapter.</u>
11	(2) The limitation under subdivision (b)(1) of this section and
12	other limitations under this subchapter shall not apply to members of the
13	armed services of the United States or their dependents under § 27-16-807, §
L4	27-16-902, or other law.
15	(c) On or before January 31, 2006, the Office of Driver Services of
16	the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall

26	To meet the requirements of this subchapter, the Office of Driver
27	Services of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and
28	Administration shall include at a minimum the following information and
29	features on each driver's license and identification card that it issues to a
30	person:
31	(1) The person's full legal name;
32	(2) The person's date of birth;
33	(3) The person's gender;
34	(4) The person's driver's license or identification card number;
35	(5) A digital photograph of the person;
36	(6) The person's address of residence:

1	(/) The person's signature;
2	(8) Physical security features designed to prevent tampering,
3	counterfeiting, or duplication of the document for fraudulent purposes; and
4	(9) A common machine-readable technology with defined minimum

7	27-16-1105. Minimum issuance standards for driver's licenses.
8	(a)(1) Except as provided under subdivisions (a)(2) and (b)(1) of this
9	section regarding the renewal, duplication, or reissuance of a driver's
10	license or identification card, to meet the requirements of this section the
11	Office of Driver Services of the Revenue Division of the Department of
12	Finance and Administration shall require at a minimum presentation of the
13	following information before issuing a driver's license or identification
14	card to a person:
15	(A) A photo identity document, except that a nonphoto
16	identity document is acceptable if it includes both the person's full legal
17	name and date of birth;
18	(B) Documentation showing the person's date of birth;
19	(C) Proof of the person's social security account number
20	or verification that the person is not eligible for a social security account
21	number; and
22	(D) Evidence of legal status that includes valid
23	documentary evidence that the person:
24	(i) Is a citizen of the United States;
25	(ii) Is an alien lawfully admitted for permanent or
26	temporary residence in the United States;
27	(iii) Has conditional permanent resident status in
28	the United States;
29	(iv) Has a valid, unexpired nonimmigrant visa or
30	nonimmigrant visa status for entry into the United States;
31	(v) Has a pending or approved application for asylum
32	in the United States;
33	(vi) Has entered into the United States in refugee
34	status;
35	(vii) Has a pending or approved application for
36	temporary protected status in the United States:

1	(viii) Has approved deterred action status; or
2	(ix) Has a pending application for adjustment of
3	status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence in the
4	United States or conditional permanent resident status in the United States.
5	(2)(A) If ten (10) or more driver's licenses are issued with the
6	same address of residence, the applicant shall present documentation that
7	establishes the person's address of residence.
8	(B) The documentation requirements under subdivision
9	(a)(2) of this section shall include, but not be limited to:
10	(i) A lease;
11	(ii) A mortgage statement; or
12	(iii) A utility bill.
13	(b)(1) For purposes of subsection (a) of this section and except as
L 4	provided in subdivision (b)(2) of this section, the Office of Driver Services
15	of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
16	presume that any driver's license or identification card for which an
L 7	application has been made for renewal, duplication, or reissuance has been
18	issued in accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of this section if
19	at the time the application was made the driver's license or identification
20	card had not expired or been cancelled, suspended, or revoked.
21	(2) Subdivision (b)(1) of this section shall not apply to a
22	renewal, duplication, or reissuance of a driver's license or identification

32	Department of Finance and Administration shall not accept any foreign
33	document other than an official passport to satisfy a requirement of
34	subsection (a) or (b) of this section; and
35	(2) No later than January 31, 2006, the Director of the
36	Department of Finance and Administration shall enter into a memorandum of

1	understanding with the Secretary of the United States Department of Homeland
2	Security to routinely utilize the automated system known as Systematic Alien
3	Verification for Entitlements, as provided for by section 404 of the Illegal
4	Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (110 Stat. 3009-
5	664), to verify the legal presence status of a person other than a United
6	States citizen applying for a driver's license or identification card.

8	27-16-1106. Additional requirements.
9	To meet the requirements of this section regarding the issuance of
10	driver's licenses and identification cards, the Director of the Department of
11	Finance and Administration shall:
12	(1) Retain paper copies of source documents for a minimum of
13	seven (7) years or images of source documents presented for a minimum of ten
14	(10) years;
15	(2) Subject each person applying for a driver's license or
16	identification card to mandatory digital facial image capture;
17	(3)(A) Confirm with the Social Security Administration a social
18	security account number presented by a person using the full social security
19	account number.
20	(B) In the event that a social security account number is
21	already registered to or associated with another person to which the Office
22	of Driver Services of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and
23	Administration has issued a driver's license or identification card, the
24	office shall resolve the discrepancy and take appropriate action;
25	(4) Refuse to issue a driver's license or identification card to
26	a person holding a driver's license issued by another state without
27	confirmation that the person is terminating or has terminated the driver's

30	licenses and identification cards are produced and the security of document
31	materials and papers from which driver's licenses and identification cards
32	are produced;
33	(6) Subject all persons authorized to manufacture or produce
34	driver's licenses and identification cards to appropriate security clearance
35	requirements to include, but not be limited to, criminal background checks;

1	(7) Establish fraudulent document recognition training programs
2	for the employees of the Office of Driver Services of the Revenue Division of
3	the Department of Finance and Administration who are engaged in the issuance
4	of driver's licenses and identification cards.

6	27-16-1107. Linking of databases.
7	(a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
8	ensure that the State of Arkansas is eligible to receive any grant or other
9	type of financial assistance made available under federal law regarding
10	driver's license security and modernization.
11	(b) The director shall implement and oversee a motor vehicle database
12	that contains at a minimum the following information:
13	(1) All data fields printed on driver's licenses and
14	identification cards issued by the Office of Driver Services of the Revenue
15	<u>Division of the Department of Finance and Administration of the State of</u>
16	Arkansas; and
17	(2) Motor vehicle driver's histories, including motor vehicle
18	violations, suspensions, and points on licenses.
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20	<u>27-16-1108. Rules.</u>
21	The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
22	promulgate rules to implement and administer this subchapter.

24	27-16-1109. Applicability to Medicaid identification cards.
25	No provision of this subchapter shall apply to the issuance or
26	production of Medicaid identification cards by either the Department of Human
27	Services or the Office of Driver Services of the Revenue Division of the
28	Department of Finance and Administration.
