SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 16-17-705 is amended to read as follows:

16-17-705. Filing fees and costs. [Effective January 1, 2005.] (a)(1) The Effective January 1, 2006, the uniform filing fee to be charged by the clerks of the district courts for initiating a cause of action in municipal district court in this state shall be as prescribed in this section. (2) No portion of the filing fee shall be refunded. (b)(1) For initiating a cause of action in the civil division of district court\$35.00 \$50.00 (2) For initiating a cause of action in the small claims division of district court, if that division is established pursuant to the Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 80, § 7(D)\$25.00 \$40.00 (c) No municipality shall authorize, and no district court clerk shall assess or collect, any other filing fees than those authorized by this act, unless specifically provided by state law.
