15 TO CLARIFY THAT A MOTOR HOME OR CAMPING

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-35-210(a)(2), regarding permits for
24 special cargo, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as
25 follows:

26 (D)(i) It shall not be necessary to obtain a permit, and
27 it shall be lawful to move any motor home or camping trailer in excess of the
28 maximum width prescribed under § 27-35-206 if the excess width is
29 attributable to a noncargo carrying appurtenance that extends no more than
30 six inches (6") beyond the body of the vehicle.

31 (ii) As used in this section, "appurtenance" means:
32 (a) Awnings and awning support hardware; and
33 (b) Any appendage that is intended to be an
34 integral part of a motor home or camping trailer.
