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23	SECTION 1. Arka	ansas Code § 6-82-1002 is amended t	to read as follows:

27	(1)(A) "A	Approved institution" means a publi	i c or private college,

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- 1 the provisions of applicable state and federal law public-supported or 2 private, non-profit postsecondary institution with its primary headquarters located in Arkansas that is eligible to receive Title IV Federal student aid 3 4 funds or any nursing school with its primary headquarters located in Arkansas that is eligible to participate in Title IV Federal student aid programs and 5 6 has been approved by the Department of Higher Education as eligible to 7 participate in the Academic Challenge Scholarship Program; 8 (2) "Eligible student" means any student who meets the criteria 9 set out by this subchapter and who is deemed to be eligible by rules and regulations authorized by this subchapter and promulgated by the Department 10 11 of Higher Education; (3) "Financial need" means the family income of program 12 13 applicants as determined by the Department of Higher Education through evaluation of program applications and supporting documentation; 14 15 (4)(A) "Full-time undergraduate student" means a resident of 16 Arkansas who attends an approved institution of higher education and who is 17 enrolled for at least twelve (12) credit hours the first semester and fifteen (15) hours thereafter or the equivalent, as defined by the Department of 18 19 Higher Education, in a program of study that leads to or is creditable toward a baccalaureate degree, an associate degree in nursing, or a nursing school 20 21 diploma;. 22 (B) A recipient receiving an Arkansas Academic Challenge 23 Scholarship for the eighth semester shall not be required to be enrolled in 24 fifteen (15) hours and shall be considered a "full-time undergraduate student" if the recipient is enrolled in the appropriate number of course 25 26 credit hours to earn a degree at the end of that semester. (5) "Recipient" means an applicant awarded a scholarship funded
- 27 28 through the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program;
- 29 (6) "Tuition" means charges levied for attendance at an eligible 30 institution of higher education, including mandatory fees charged to all full-time students by an approved institution; and 31
- 32 "Unemancipated child" or "unemancipated children" means a 33 dependent child or dependent children as defined by the United States 34 Department of Education for student aid purposes.

36 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code \S 6-82-1005(b)(6)(D)(iii), concerning

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1	eligibility for the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program, is		
2	amended to read as follows:		
3	(iii) In calculating financial need for applicants		
4	who graduate graduated from an Arkansas high school after December 31, 2000,		
5	but before December 31, 2004, the following criteria shall be used:		
6	(a) An applicant whose family includes one (1)		
7	unemancipated child shall have average family adjusted gross income over the		
8	previous two (2) years not exceeding fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) per		
9	year at the time of application to the program;		
10	(b) An applicant whose family includes two (2)		
11	unemancipated children shall have average family adjusted gross income over		
12	the previous two (2) years not exceeding fifty-five thousand dollars		
13	(\$55,000) per year at the time of application to the program;		
14	(c) An applicant whose family includes three		
15	(3) or more unemancipated children shall have average family adjusted gross		
16	income over the previous two (2) years not exceeding sixty thousand dollars		
17	(\$60,000) per year at the time of application to the program, plus for		
18	families with more than three (3) unemancipated children, an additional five		
19	thousand dollars (\$5,000) per year for each additional child; and		
20	(d) Any applicant whose family includes more		
21	than one (1) unemancipated child enrolled full time at an approved		
22	institution of higher education shall be entitled to an additional ten		
23	thousand dollars (\$10,000) of adjusted gross income for each additional child

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27	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code \S 6-82-1005(b)(6)(D), concerning eligibility		
28	for the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program, is amended to add ar		
29	additional subdivision to read as follows:		
30	(iv) In calculating financial need for applicants		
31	who graduate from an Arkansas high school after December 31, 2004, a Free		
32	Application for Federal Student Aid or a subsequent application required by		
33	the United States Department of Education for federal financial aid shall be		
34	filed by the applicant or other proof of family income as defined by the		
35	Department of Higher Education and the following criteria shall be used:		
36	(a) An applicant whose family includes one (1)		

1	unemancipated child shall have average family adjusted gross income over the		
2	previous two (2) years not exceeding sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) per		
3	year at the time of application to the program;		
4	(b) An applicant whose family includes two (2)		
5	unemancipated children shall have average family adjusted gross income over		
6	the previous two (2) years not exceeding sixty-five thousand dollars		
7	(\$65,000) per year at the time of application to the program;		
8	(c) An applicant whose family includes three		
9	(3) or more unemancipated children shall have average family adjusted gross

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21	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code \S 6-82-1006(c)(4), concerning the amount of		
22	the Academic Challenge Scholarship award, is amended to read as follows:		
23	(4) For Beginning with awards made for the 2005-2006 academic		
24	year for recipients who graduated from high school after December 31, 2001,		
25	the amount of the annual scholarship awarded to each recipient shall be		
26	graduated as follows:		
27	(A) A recipient in his or her freshman year shall be		
28	awarded an amount not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000) <u>two thousand</u>		
29	five hundred dollars (\$2,500);		
30	(B) A recipient in his or her sophomore year shall be		
31	awarded an amount not to exceed two thousand two hundred fifty dollars		
32	(\$2,250) two thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$2,750);		
33	(C) A recipient in his or her junior year shall be awarded		
34	an amount not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) <u>three</u>		
35	thousand dollars (\$3,000); and		
36	(D) A recipient in his or her senior year shall be awarded		

1	an amount not to exceed three thousand dollars (\$3,000) <u>three thousand five</u>		
2	hundred dollars (\$3,500).		
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4	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
5	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the financial eligibility		
6	requirements for the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program must be		
7	clarified; that clarification of the eligibility requirements for financial		
8	need will help more Arkansas students enter and complete their post-secondary		
9	education; and that this act is immediately necessary to prevent student		
10	hardships and provide stability for the 2005-2006 school year. Therefore, an		
11	emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for		
12	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become		
13	effective on:		
14	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
15	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
16	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
17	bill; or		
18	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
19	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
