10 AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPORTING OF INFORMATION
11 PERTAINING TO METHAMPHETAMINE LABS SEIZURES; AND
12 FOR OTHER PUPOSES.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1 is amended
23 to add an additional section to read as follows:

24 12-12-105. Methamphetamine lab seizure reports.

25 (a)(1) Each state and local law enforcement agency shall report all
26 methamphetamine lab seizures to the State Crime Laboratory within thirty (30)
27 days of the date of the seizure.

28 (2) With thirty (30) days of receipt of the report, the State
29 Crime Laboratory shall furnish the information contained in the report to
30 the:

31 (A) United States Drug Enforcement Administration; and

32 (B) Office of National Drug Control Policy.

33 (b) The State Crime Laboratory shall provide any available statistical
34 information that is requested by the United States Drug Enforcement
35 Administration or the Office of National Drug Control Policy concerning
36 reported methamphetamine lab seizures.
