AN ACT TO PROMOTE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BY
AMENDING VARIOUS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS
PROVIDING BUSINESS INCENTIVE ASSISTANCE TO
MANUFACTURERS OF CEMENT WHO INVEST A MINIMUM OF
ONE HUNDRED FIFTY MILLION DOLLARS (\$150,000,000)
IN A CAPITAL INVESTMENT PROJECT BETWEEN MARCH 31,
2005 AND MARCH 31, 2008; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO PROMOTE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BY
AMENDING VARIOUS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
PROGRAMS PROVIDING BUSINESS INCENTIVE
ASSISTANCE TO MANUFACTURERS OF CEMENT
WHO INVEST A MINIMUM OF ONE HUNDRED
FIFTY MILLION DOLLARS (\$150,000,000).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to promote economic development
by providing greater business incentives to do business in the State of
Arkansas.
