## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PERMIT LANDOWNERS AND LESSES TO MOW
ADJOINING HIGHWAY OR ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PERMIT LANDOWNERS AND LESSEES
TO MOW ADJOINING HIGHWAY OR ROAD RIGHTS-
OF-WAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-64-103(a), pertaining to mowing of rights-of-way by adjoining landowners, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(l)(A) The owners and lessees of properties which abut the rights-of-way of interstate, federal-aid primary, state, or county roads or highways in this state may enter upon and mow gross grass, weeds, and other vegetation on the portion of the rights-of-way adjoining their property unless the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department or the county has installed barriers designed to prohibit such mowing or unless the property owners have received notice from the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department or the county restricting or prohibiting such mowing.
(B) A lessee shall carry a minimum of one million dollars $(\$ 1,000,000)$ in liability insurance and one million dollars $(\$ 1,000,000)$ in property damage insurance before entering on and mowing a highway right-ofway.
(2) If the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department
or a county has installed barriers which prevent access to the right-of-way, a landowner or a lessee may install a gate.
