## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT COUNTIES MAY EMPLOY DISTRICT COURT JUDGES AS CRIMINAL MAGISTRATES; TO ALLOW COUNTIES TO COMPENSATE DISTRICT COURT JUDGES FOR ACTING AS CRIMINAL MAGISTRATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT COUNTIES MAY EMPLOY DISTRICT COURT JUDGES AS CRIMINAL MAGISTRATES AND TO ALLOW COUNTIES TO COMPENSATE DISTRICT COURT JUDGES FOR ACTING AS CRIMINAL MAGISTRATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

16-17-135. Counties authorized to employ and compensate district court judges as criminal magistrates.
(a)(1) A county may employ one (1) or more district court judges to act as criminal magistrates in accordance with the provisions of Rule 1.8(a) of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure.
(2) A district court judge acting as a criminal magistrate may be authorized to perform any of the duties described in Rule $1.8(b)$ of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure.
(b) A county may compensate a district court judge acting as a criminal magistrate in excess of his or her salary as a district court judge




in an annual amount not to exceed fifty percent (50\%) of the district court
judge's maximum annual salary as set forth in § 16-17-108. 2 $\square$
