4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-62-101, concerning survival actions, is
5	amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
6	(c)(1) An action under this section shall be commenced within three
7	(3) years after the death of the decedent.
8	(2) If a nonsuit or dismissal without prejudice is suffered by a
9	party bringing an action under this section, then the action shall be
10	commenced within one (1) year from the date of the nonsuit or dismissal
11	without regard to the date of the death of the decedent.
12	(3) This section shall be liberally construed in favor of the
13	party bringing the action.
14	(4) If a cause of action under this section is brought by at
15	least one (1) heir at law, then the cause of action shall be preserved for
16	the purpose of time limitations for filing the action.
17	(5)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(5)(B) of this
18	section, if an action filed under this section fails to comply with a
19	requirement of this section, then:
20	(i) The party bringing the action shall be allowed
21	to amend the pleadings to conform with this section, and the amended
22	pleadings shall relate back to the date when the action was originally filed;

35	(2)(A) If there is no personal representative, then the action
36	shall may be brought by the beirs at law of the deceased person.

1	(B) As used in this section, "heir at law" or "heirs at	
2	law" includes any of the following:	
3	(i) If the decedent died testate, a person who takes	
4	real, personal, tangible, or intangible property:	
5	(a) Under the decedent's will, by right of	
6	survivorship or by tenancy by the entirety; and	
7	(b) Is a beneficiary under § 16-62-102;	
8	(ii) If the decedent died intestate, all of the	
9	persons to whom the heritable estate passes as provided under § 28-9-214; or	
10	(iii) All of the beneficiaries under § 16-62-102.	
11		
12	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 16-62-102(c), concerning wrongful death	
13	actions, is amended to read as follows:	
14	(c)(l) Every action authorized by this section shall be commenced	
15	within three (3) years after the death of the person alleged to have been	
16	wrongfully killed.	
17	(2) If a nonsuit or dismissal without prejudice is suffered, the	
18	action shall be brought within one (1) year from the date of the nonsuit or	
19	<u>dismissal</u> without regard to the date of the death of the person alleged to	
20	have been wrongfully killed.	
21	(3) This section shall be liberally construed in favor of the	
22	party bringing the action.	
23	(4) If a cause of action under this section is brought by at	
24	least one (1) heir at law, then the cause of action shall be preserved for	
25	the purpose of time limitations for filing the action.	
26	(5)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(5)(B) of this

5	actions, is amended to read as follows:
6	(d) The party bringing an action under this section may pursue a claim
7	on behalf of the following beneficiaries, regardless of whether the
8	beneficiaries are parties to the action of the action created in this section
9	are:
10	(1) The surviving spouse, children, father, mother, brothers,
11	and sisters of the deceased person;
12	(2) Persons, regardless of age, standing in loco parentis to the
13	deceased person; and
14	(3) Persons, regardless of age, to whom the deceased stood in
15	loco parentis at any time during the life of the deceased.
16	
17	SECTION 6. This act shall apply to any of the following causes of
18	action:
19	(1) All pending actions in this state as of the effective date
20	of this act;
21	(2) Actions that have not yet been filed and are not time-barred
22	as of the effective date of this act; and
23	(3) Actions that have not yet accrued as of the effective date
24	of this act.
25	
26	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
27	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the courts have misinterpreted
28	the survival and wrongful death law to the detriment of the beneficiaries of
29	decedents' estates; that the actions are being dismissed with prejudice,
30	amended pleadings to correct technical probate errors are not being allowed,
31	and complaints are being declared a nullity, all of which is against the
32	public policy of this state to provide every person his or her day in court,
33	especially when it involves the death of a loved one; that this act is
34	intended to clarify existing law; and that this act is immediately necessary
35	to prevent further injustice to the loved ones of a decedent. Therefore, an
36	emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for

1	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become		
2	effective on:		
3	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
4	(2) If the act is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
5	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
6	bill; or		
7	(3) If the act is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
8	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
