For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY MAY DESIGNATE ARKANSAS
STATE UNIVERSITY-HEBER SPRINGS AS AN INDEPENDENT
CAMPUS OF ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD OF
TRUSTEES OF ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY
MAY ESTABLISH ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY-
HEBER SPRINGS AS AN INDEPENDENT CAMPUS
OF ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 65, Subchapter 2 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-65-227. ASU-Heber Springs.

(a) The Board of Trustees of Arkansas State University may designate Arkansas State University-Heber Springs as an independent campus of Arkansas State University.

(b) The Board of Trustees of Arkansas State University may exercise any powers, rights, and obligations in regard to Arkansas State University-Heber Springs that it may exercise in regard to Arkansas State University.

(c) The Board of Trustees of Arkansas State University may designate the counties of Faulkner, Lonoke, Prairie, White, Pulaski, Cleburne, Stone, Independence, and Van Buren as composing the district for Arkansas State
