TO CONFORM THE ARKANSAS CODE TO COMPLY WITH THE ARKANSAS SUPREME COURT DECISION IN THE LAKE VIEW CASE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) The General Assembly:
(1) Recognizes that the Arkansas Constitution, as interpreted by the Arkansas Supreme Court in Lake View School District No. 25 v. Huckabee, 351 Ark. 31 (2002), makes education a paramount duty of the state;
(2) Finds that the Arkansas Constitution requires the state to provide an adequate education.
(b) The purpose of this section is to conform the Arkansas Code to comply with the recent Arkansas Supreme Court decision in the Lake View case and other things necessary for improvement of education.
(c) The purpose of this section is to set forth measures to provide equality of educational opportunity, including as basic components rich
curricula, sufficient teachers' salaries, adequate facilities, and necessary
equipment for obtaining an adequate education.
