## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP ON THE BOARD OF  
10 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SERVICES; TO PROVIDE  
11 FOR APPOINTMENTS TO THE BOARD BY THE SPEAKER OF  
12 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE PRESIDENT  
13 PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-48-203 is amended to read as follows:

25 20-48-203. Board of Developmental Disabilities Services - Creation -  
26 Members.

27 (a)(1) The Board of Developmental Disabilities Services shall consist  
28 of ~~seven (7)~~ nine (9) members, at least one (1) of whom shall be a woman, who  
29 shall be citizens and residents of the State of Arkansas and more than  
30 twenty-five (25) years of age.

31 (2) One (1) of the members shall be a resident of each of the  
32 six (6) former congressional districts established by Acts 1951, No. 297  
33 [repealed].

34 (3) The ~~seventh~~ ninth shall be a member at large.

35 (b) Upon completion of the term of each member, a successor shall be  
36 appointed for a term of seven (7) years.



1 (c) Appointment to fill a vacancy arising other than by expiration of  
2 a term of office shall be for the unexpired portion thereof.

3 (d) ~~(1) Appointment shall be made by the~~ The Governor shall appoint  
4 seven (7) members with the advice and consent of the Senate.

5 (2) One (1) member shall be appointed by the Speaker of the  
6 House of Representatives.

7 (3) One (1) member shall be appointed by the President Pro  
8 Tempore of the Senate.

9 (e) The board shall serve without compensation, except that each board  
10 member may receive expense reimbursement and stipends in accordance with §  
11 25-16-901 et seq.
