an act to prohibit smoking of tobacco in or near STATE BUILDINGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT SMOKING IN OR NEAR STATE BUILDINGS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-1-102 is amended to read as follows: 25-1-102. State agency smoking policies.
(a) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:
(1) "General office space" means space occupied by personnel performing their daily work functions;
(2)(1) "Smoking" means the use of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any other ignited tobacco product by a person; and
(3)(2) "State agency" means any department, agency, board, commission, office, educational or correctional institution, or other authority of the state.
(b) The chief administrative officer of each state agency shall promulgate a smoking policy for the general office space of the state agency. The policy shall take into consideration the rights of both nonsmokers and smokers.
(b) Smoking is unlawful in or on any property, including vehicles, owned or leased by any state agency.
(c) A copy of this section shall be posted in a conspicuous location at every entrance to each building owned or leased by a state agency.
