21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-19-105(b), concerning records not open
24 to examination and copying, is amended to add an additional subdivision as
25 follows:

26 (17) Home addresses and property tax assessment information of
27 state judges, federal judges and magistrates, prosecuting attorneys, deputy
28 and assistant prosecuting attorneys, United States Attorneys, and assistant
29 United States Attorneys.

31 SECTION 2. (a) Any county that maintains a website allowing access to
32 property tax assessment records of the public shall not allow access to the
33 information by solely entering the name of the taxpayer.

34 (b) A county shall not allow access to property tax assessment records
35 of the public based on the name of the taxpayer only.
